## Write with the right pen

Many students prefer to use pens in their classes. I do too, so I decided to compare two of the pens that I use the most during classes. The first pen was the Pilot FriXion Clicker 0.7, the second was the Pilot G2 0.7 Gel Pen. I ended up liking the G2 pen better, but I will let you decide for yourself! You can buy either of these at any Kroger, Target, Walmat, etc. They are also sold on Amazon!

I will use a 5 star rating system for each category that I use to compare the pens. I will use 3 categories that I find the most important when figuring out which pens to get. The three categories are as follows. How smoothly the pen writes, the quality of the ink, and the grip of the pen.



While both pens write very smooth on paper, the G2 pen is significantly more consistent when it comes to the quality of writing. The FriXion pen can sometimes appear more faded, due to the erasable ink, which becomes invisible when under heat.

FriXion - 3/5 G2 - 5/5

I personall prefer the G2 pen when it comes to the quality of ink. It is always consistent and the ink tends to last longer. The bright colors also are always strongly represented. The FriXion pen, on the other hand, is erasable, which can be a pain, especially when your paper accidentally gets hot, and all of your work erases! That being said, the FriXion pen does no smear underneath highlighter, which is a quality I really like about it.

FriXion - 3/5 G2 - 4/5







The FriXion pen is much prefered when it comes to the grip of the pen in your hand. The holding does not slip, and is always comfortable. The G2 pen can get uncomfortable, which can be a dealbreaker for many.

FriXion - 5/5 G2 - 3/5
